Dear Parent

I enclose a copy of your son/daughter's Progress Check. The gradings reflect the average standard of work produced since students began their A2 Level courses having returned from study leave in June. The numbers reflect the level of effort demonstrated in the four areas of Attitude to Learning, Homework, Attendance and Punctuality. We have used a scale with 1 being excellent and 5 being very poor. Students have already seen their Progress Check and used this information with the help of their tutor and subject teachers to set targets to aid their future studies.
