Students opt for Sixth Form subjects following a series of guidance meetings with senior staff, which start in February of Year 11. Final subjects are selected in August during an enrolment meeting after results are received.

Students can choose to complete an EPQ (Extended Project Qualification) or an enrichment programme. Those without a GCSE at grade 4 will take the relevant English or Maths resit classes.

Following an end of year guidance meeting students will enrol into Year 13 at the end of Year 12. They will either continue with 3 or 4 A' Level subjects, or may opt for a combination of AS and A' Level subjects if they have chosen to sit an AS exam in year 12.

All Year 13 students will also attend at least 1 hour of enrichment each week. This can include the study of the following qualifications:
