Year 10 Summer Holiday Tasks

As part of their transition into Yr.11, students will receive summer holiday tasks in all subjects. These activities are carefully designed to be manageable for students and to consolidate their understanding of the key topics taught in Yr.10. Also, given the linear structure of the GCSE courses where content is examined at the end of Yr.11, these tasks will be very helpful for their GCSE revision. We ask for your support in ensuring that your child spends some time completing these activities ahead of their return to school in September.

<u>Uniform</u>
