Dear Parents/Carers

I thought it timely that I write to you with an update regarding the arrangements for school after the May half term holiday.

The School Day:

Regarding the timings of the school day, they will remain unchanged. Students will continue to attend for their tutorial session at 8.40am each morning and we will continue with the current timetable until at least the 21st June.

Lateral Flow Tests:

Can I also take this opportunity to remind you to continue using the lateral flow tests twice a week. We recommend Wednesday evening or Thursday morning and Sunday evening or Monday morning. This is particularly important given the risk of the new variant within North Tyneside.
