## Year 9 Curriculum 2021 - 2022

Thank you for choosing Whitley Bay High School for the next stage of your child's education. We are looking forward to meeting you and your daughter/son as they begin their High School life. We want this to be the start of a partnership which allows your daughter/son to enjoy all aspects of school and then go on to fulfil or exceed their potential.

Now that you have received confirmation of your child's place I would like to tell you a little more about our curriculum offer in Year 9.

Students at Whitley Bay High School follow a compulsory curriculum and they also choose one option subject. Details of these options can be found in the Options Information Booklet on the school website (Lower School: Year 8 Options: Year 8 Options Booklet).

**Compulsory Subjects:** Students in Year 9 study a number of compulsory subjects already studied in Years 7 and 8. These subjects are English; Mathematics; Science; Technology; Physical Education; Life, Enquiry and Values (including Religious Education, Health Education, Careers, Critical Thinking and British Citizenship); History; Geography; Art and a language option.

Students choose from French, German or Spanish as their compulsory language option. Students may then continue this subject in Years 10 and 11 for a GCSE Language qualification if they wish to do so. For students wishing to study two languages, French or German may also be chosen as an Option Choice, but only if it has been studied in Year 8.

**Option Choice:** In addition to the compulsory subjects, students in Year 9 at Whitley Bay High School also choose one optional subject from Drama, French, German, PE, Jewellery Technology, Robotics, Music, or Philosophy and Ethics.

Students opting for extra PE should be considering taking PE at GCSE level.

It is important that students also select a reserve choice, as it is not always possible to accommodate all students' choices due to constraints of staffing and specialist facilities. However, we do try to meet their individual needs.

Please can you and your daughter/son complete the online Admission Form, by clicking on the link, which can be found on the school website (Lower School: Year 8 Options). Please select the chosen options within this form.

If you do not hear from us, your daughter/son has secured their first choice option subject. If the reserve choice has been allocated I will write to you to let you know at the beginning of May.
