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Entry Requirements

This is a challenging A level and you will need to be self motivated and determined to succeed. A minimum grade 6 in both science courses and a grade 6 in mathematics is required. Students studying Chemistry, Biology and Physics as GCSE separate sciences, must achieve a minimum of a grade 6 in Chemistry and one other science. Students must also achieve a minimum of a grade 6 in GCSE mathematics.

Year 12
